This year marks a milestone: the 20th anniversary of Edinburgh Art Fair (EAF)! Since our humble beginnings in 2005, EAF has grown into Scotland's most celebrated art fair, a beacon of creativity in Europe, and a highlight in the calendar of Scottish art lovers. Over two decades, we've championed art that transcends boundaries—geographic, financial, and cultural—and we're thrilled to invite you to join our anniversary celebration this September.

And, importantly, we've proven that great art isn't just for the elite, ensuring everyone can take home a piece of original creativity.

Fostering Community: Charitable Partnerships and Children's Creativity

EAF firmly believes art extends far beyond gallery walls and proudly upholds its role as a force for good. Since 2005, the fair has worked alongside organizations such as CHAS, Maggie's, St Columba's Hospice, East Lothian Special Needs Playscheme, and Garvald, raising both awareness and essential funds for charitable programs. In particular, St Columba's Hospice and Garvald Edinburgh will once again feature at this year's fair, exhibiting works created by or in collaboration with their communities. Proceeds from these sales directly support the charities' services— allowing visitors to discover meaningful pieces while contributing to a lasting social impact.

Meanwhile, the Kids' Art Group provides a welcoming, hands-on creative space where young minds can paint, draw, and freely unleash their imaginations under the guidance of the Edinburgh Art Shop team. The idea is simple: when children feel inspired, the entire community reaps the benefits of their creative spark.

Art for Everyone: Our Promise

We know galleries can feel intimidating. That's why EAF was built on a radical idea: art belongs to all. That's why we go beyond exhibitions to create an inclusive, welcoming space where visitors can connect with art in meaningful ways:

Affordable & Accessible – Whether a first-time buyer or a seasoned collector, you'll find original artwork ranging from £100 to £50,000. (Yes, £100 buys real art—not mass-produced posters!)

Beyond the Walls – Free artist talks, live demonstrations, and Q&A sessions break down barriers, allowing visitors to engage directly with creators.

For All Ages – Families and young art lovers can enjoy kids' craft workshops and book readings, making art a playful and immersive experience. conversations with artists to relaxed chats over a coffee or glass of wine, every moment invites you to be part of a larger community celebration of creativity.

Since 2005, we've partnered with charities like CHAS, Maggie's, St Columba's Hospice, East Lothian Special Needs Playscheme, and Garvald, helping to raise awareness and much-needed funds to support therapy and community programs.
